**In Oakland County...**  
**2nd Moore Enters Race For Judge**

The ballot for Oakland county probate court judge in November will have two Moores on it. Also running will be a Royal Oak city commissioner, John R. Osgood.

Incumbent Judge Arthur E. Moore will run in a separate contest from Ralph S. Moore who announced his candidacy for the newly-created judgeship on May 9.

The second Moore is an attorney and former member of the firm of Moore, Clarkston and Best. He served as assistant prosecuting attorney under former prosecutor Frederick S. Zim, now a circuit judge.

Osgood, who also announced his candidacy May 9, is a member of the Oakland County board of supervisors and was recently appointed to head the supervisors' building committee. He is a resident of Royal Oak.

**School Board Group Studies Library Problem**

Utilizing suggestions made at a recent meeting of the board of directors of the Oakland county school board members association, Bloomfield Hills school board president Merrill O. Bates and deputy superintendent of Oakland schools Ken Brown have announced the formation of a five-person steering committee. It will thoroughly study recommendations for school libraries set by the national association of librarians.

Steering committee groups will cover phases of study in the 21 school districts in Oakland county. They will check libraries to see if improvements can be made and to correlate school and public library services.

**Woodward Repairs Stated Until Fall**

Commuters can plan to detour around repairs for most of the summer as they travel Woodward, avenue between Eight Mile and Pontiac.

The state highway department anticipates that work crews will need until fall to install 3,500 square yards of concrete patching and repair of joint failures. Once all blacktopping is also planned.
