Oakland county's total equalized valuation jumps by 6.09 per cent—from \$1,893,302,300 to \$2,008,519,100—this week, as a result of the state equalization board's boost of county valuations, approved Tuesday. The jump means a slight increase for Birmingham area communities: county, township and school taxes.

The county equalization committee has concurred in the increases according to Equalization Director William Grabendick. The state-wide average increase was 10.8 per cent. Oakland county's increase was lower, Grabendick said. Birmingham area figures have been kept at state levels for the last few years.

The state increase was designed to keep assessed valuations at approximately 50 per cent of current market value, which the board adopted several years ago as a standard.

The effect of the increase on the Birmingham schools' '60-'61 budget will be slight, because the school figures are based on a projected increase when working out the budget.

New equalization factors for communities in the Birmingham area are:

Birmingham—1.37, Bloomfield Hills—1.89, Bloomfield township—1.88, West Bloomfield township—1.83, Southfield township—1.61, Troy—1.17, Lathrup Village—1.91

The equalization factor is not applied to city or village taxes.

City controller Clark Hagstrom said the equalization factor applied to county and school taxes paid in Birmingham last year was 1.22. The new hike to 1.37, Hagstrom said, would mean a hike equal to \$1.45 per each \$1,000 of assessed valuation.

TROY—Troy adopted the largest operating budget in the city Monday but failed to fill a \$74,000 revenue spot.

Commissioners okayed a \$748,532 budget some \$120,232 higher than the current \$628,300 budget. A tie vote beat a proposal that would raise the needed \$74,000 in taxes to pay Troy's second installment on the Evergreen sewer.

TROY'S INCOME will be boosted \$52,500 in state related taxes due to the population increase. Another \$11,000 will come from the city's higher assessed valuation. It still leaves the city \$45,000 shy of the total amount it proposes to spend.

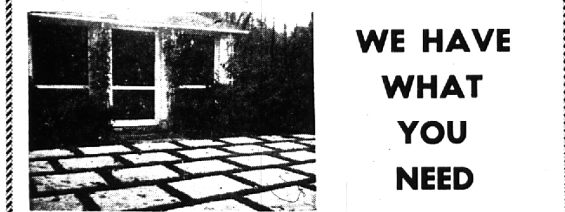

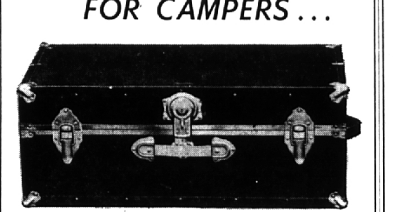
