Going—going—and Baldwin public library hopes adult fiction will soon be gone, gone into home storage under phase two of Operation Save Our Stories.

With workmen now busily engaged in remodeling what will be the new reference end of the library (formerly occupied by the Boys and Girls' Department), it won't be long before they will be ready to move into renovation operations in the adult fiction stacks.

BEFORE that time comes, says Miss Jeanne Lloyd, Librarian, storage facilities must be uncovered for the adult fiction which remains except for rental and 7-day fiction.

Thanks to the generosity of library-minded Birmingham, many adult fiction books are already checked out on long term S O S loan.

HOWEVER, Miss Lloyd and her staff are hopeful that still more families will discover they can accommodate a beautiful better yet, two-of S O S adult fiction within the next week or so. All adult fiction except rental and 7-day books are available on S O S loan.

ADULT FICTION borrowed on S O S terms will be due back at the library between July 15 and 30 while children's S O S books are due between June 1 and 7.

Since long-loan provisions extend only over books borrowed specifically under Operation S O S, all other books are due back at the library after the customary shorter loan periods.



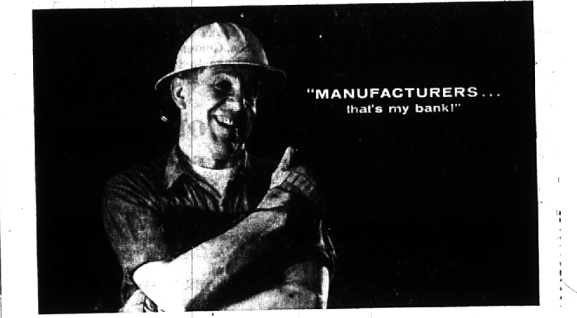

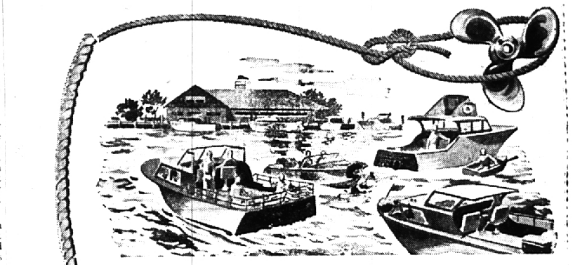
