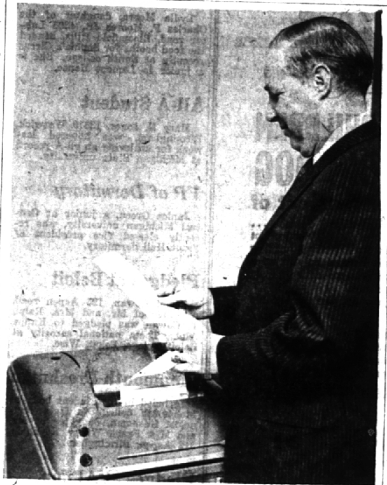

County Disburses State Aid Funds To Area Schools

The Oakland county treasurer's office today disbursed nearly \$4 million in state aid funds to school districts throughout the county. County treasurer Charles A. Sparks said the grants total \$3,983,700. The amount will be divided among the county's 32 school districts.

BIRMINGHAM WILL receive \$257,600; Southfield — \$156,160; Troy—\$91,160; Bloomfield Hills—\$63,380; and West Bloomfield township—\$45,800.

"We know how anxious local districts are to receive these funds," Sparks said. "And we're set up to process, and disburse them without delay."
