Sen. Eugene McCarthy, Democratic senator from Minnesota who notified Adlai Stevenson at the Democratic national convention last July, will be the second speaker in the 1950-51 Holy Name church culture series.

**Pontiac Expects Dec. 1 Start On Airline Service**

PONTIAC—Regularly scheduled airline service should be available to and from Pontiac by Dec. 1, according to Homer D. Hoskins, manager of Pontiac's municipal airport.

Hoskins set the target date for the first Convair transport to set down and thus begin regular service for North Central Airlines.

An 18-month trial period for the short-haul service between nine Michigan cities has been set by the Civil Aeronautics Board.

NEW FACILITIES and paving are now being completed at Pontiac to ready the port for the fledgling air service. Pontiac will have to produce an average of at least five passengers a day in order to keep the service beyond the trial period.
