This gives students a chance to learn directing styles, Broadway attitudes and techniques; to see theatre as a career or as a hobby with a broader dimension.

Will-O-Way's second purpose is to provide a showcase for Detroit players where the visiting director may find new, exciting talent which is capable of giving theatre its future leadership.

Engagement Told At Dinner Party

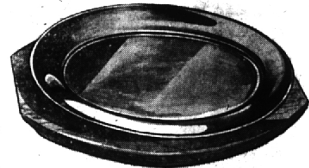

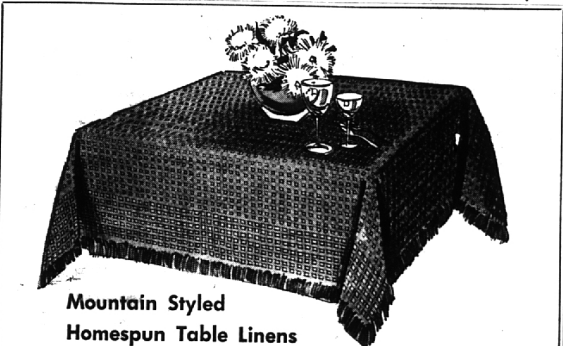
