R. Y. Moore Will Continue to Head County Auditors

Robert Y. Moore will remain as chairman of the Oakland county board of auditors. He was re-appointed by the board of supervisors last week by a vote of 55 to 18. The only challenger for the one-year position was Robert E. Lilly, secretary of the board of auditors since 1960.

Moore, on the board since 1960 and chairman since 1965, was re-appointed to the three-member board for a three-year term, receiving 63 votes. He has indicated this will be his last term. His pay will be boosted to \$18,000, beginning in January.

He was nominated by Bloomfield Hills supervisor Elmer Kephart while Lilly's nomination was made by Royal Oak supervisor John B. Osgood.

OTHER ACTION during the supervisors' meeting placed former Pontiac supervisor Maurice J. Croton on the social welfare board, replacing Thomas J. Leonard, and dropped veteran member Mrs. Sarah Garrett from the canvassing board. Leonard did not seek reappointment but will spend his time as director of the medical care facility.

Mrs. Paul Gorman of Pontiac replaced Mrs. Garrett. Mrs. Ruth Consterdyne of Royal Oak was replaced by Mrs. William Dixon, also of Royal Oak. Former Democratic county chairman Carlos G. Richardson was renominated to the three-

member canvassing board. Robert O. Pitt was given another six-year term on the board of county road commissioners. On the board for the past 12 years, his pay was raised from \$6,000 to \$10,000.

New Approach To Leadership Discussed

The Institute for leadership development, an all-day conference featuring a new approach to the problem of improving community leadership is being held today at the campus of Michigan State University.

Lawrence Borgeas, Ph. D., college of education, MSU will discuss "Motivation to Social Action." He is a member of the American vocational association and numerous other professional groups.

He was trade and industrial education chief in the U.S. Office of education for one year and has also lectured in vocational education for two years at the University of Michigan.

PURPOSE of the institute is to present tangible tools and methods for teaching adults. Individuals who have difficulty stimulating community participation in social

responsibilities will find the conference of value in presenting new leadership techniques.



