Social Groups Convene To Discuss Joint Effort

Before Oakland county's 65 social agencies, 28 churches and 32 tax-supported groups can make any major improvement in handling of youth and family problems, they must establish a vastly improved inter-agency communications system.

This was indicated Nov. 17, when 225 representatives from these social groups met together in Waterford for the first time.

A STEERING COMMITTEE meeting to evaluate facts brought forth in the conference was promised within two or three weeks by its chairman Donald C. Baldwin, superintendent of Rochester community schools.

"I hope the steering committee will be able to suggest a program which will markedly improve the communication between agencies," Baldwin commented.

Troy News Briefs

City-School Joint Meeting Set for Troy

Troy city commissioners will meet 8 p.m. Tuesday with the Troy school board to discuss mutual problems. They will discuss the traffic hazard at Hart at a north of 17-Mile (Wattie).

These methods ranged from mere liaison between the youth and the social agencies, to the handling of only one phase of the problem such as hospitalization, delinquency or family situations. The more complex the problem, the more agencies that must be involved in solving it.

"This is where the communication between agencies is most important," Baldwin pointed out.

Afternoon panelist Charles B. Brink, dean of Wayne State University's school of social work observed: "We (social agencies) seem to specialize and be non-communicative, and thus fail to cooperate with other agencies."

Another panel member, Miss Evelyn Kidnigh, director of the nursing division of the Oakland county department of health, suggested that many agencies did not know how to work together in a "real teamwork manner."

FERNDALE SCHOOL Supt. Roy E. Robinson stressed the wide range of locally-accepted concepts of education.

"At one side," Robinson said, "we have those districts which stick to teaching a child. At the other side are those communities which recognize the whole child as important and help him become the most of what he is capable of becoming."
