Engineering Group To Attempt To Set Resident Costs

SOUTHFIELD—An attempt will be made by Southfield to establish standard rates in setting costs to residents for city government. The task of setting costs financed by special taxes from property owners was referred by the city council to the consulting engineering committee for recommendation. Also studied by the committee will be a complaint made by Joe F. Reske, 20555 12 Mile road and A. A. Adol of Royal Oak. Reske and Adol said they were charged \$22 per foot for a \$84,000 paving project on property owned by them on Evergreen, south of 12 Mile. They claim the charge is excessive.

The Beverly Hills council has approved the temporary arrangement for a seven-month period.

Franklin Market Robbed of Cash In Night Theft

FRANKLIN — Several cartons of cigarettes and \$57 was taken from Goldfale market on Franklin road last week. Forcing their entrance through a window on the north side of the building, thieves ignored wine and beer stocks to rifle the cash register. They carried off only two brands of cigarettes. Apparently planned by someone familiar with the store's interior, the robbery took place after midnight, proprietor John Showers speculated. Michigan State police are handling the case.

Deny Two Uses Of Twp Park

SOUTHFIELD—Township board members denied two uses of Southfield township park on Beverly road for "budgetary" reasons. The township was asked by a group of Beverly Hills boys to build a "go-cart" race track as a recreation facility in the park to save taking the carts so far from the village. Estimated cost was \$5,000.

PERMISSION WAS also asked by a Detroit Boy Scout leader for use of the park for 10 days, about July 4, 1961, for an encampment. Trustees felt the park should be reserved for township residents during holiday periods and also noted the lack of sanitary facilities and inadequate water supply at times. They turned down the request.

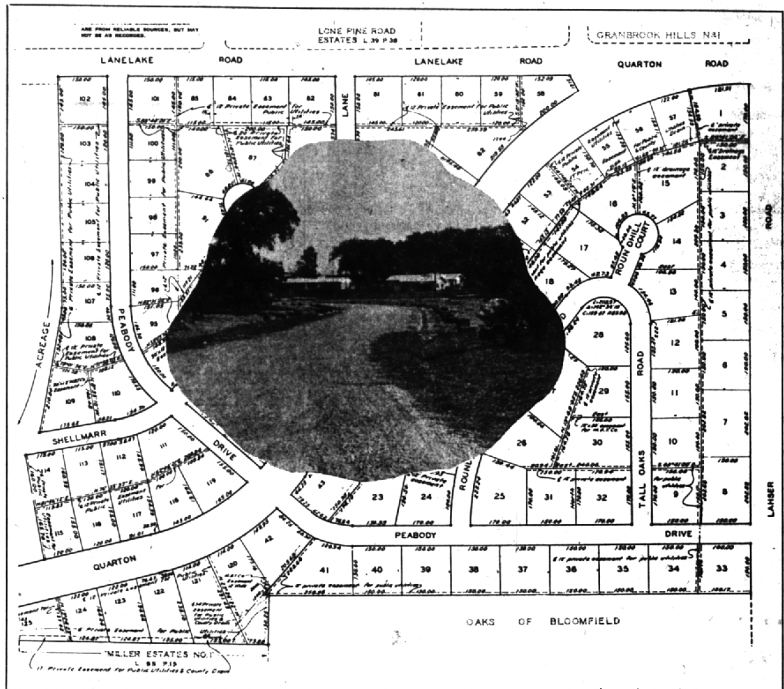
Herd Franklin's Sunday Crush

FRANKLIN—Keeping the cider visitors on the right track and the fire lanes clear on Franklin roads these past weekends, has been an over-time job for Franklin's volunteer police force. Manned the 13-Mile-Franklin road intersection for at least four hours each Sunday to keep traffic moving and enforce temporary no-left-turn restrictions. Marshall Richard Diederich has had the assistance of uniformed deputies Charles Foote, Leonard Lawton, John Donaldson, Fred Bratt and Frank Young.

WITH TRAFFIC jams as far back as Northwestern, every effort is made to keep the southbound lane open for emergencies. Eastbound traffic on 13 Mile is not allowed to make left turns during peak hours. Franklin police also assist Bloomfield township officers attempting to clear the bottle-neck at 14 Mile and the Cider Mill.

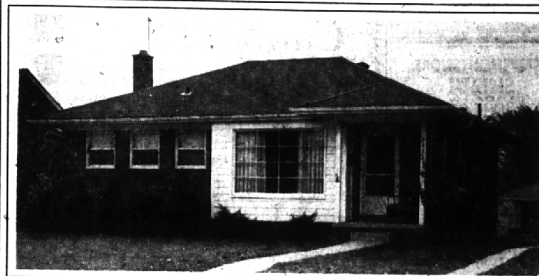

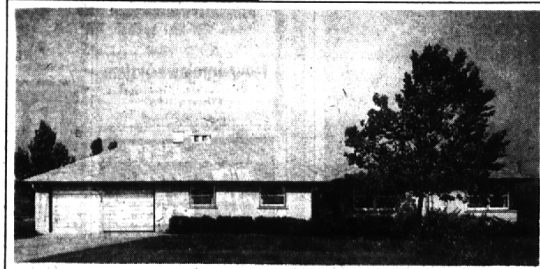

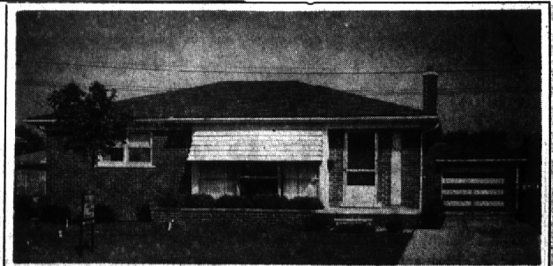
