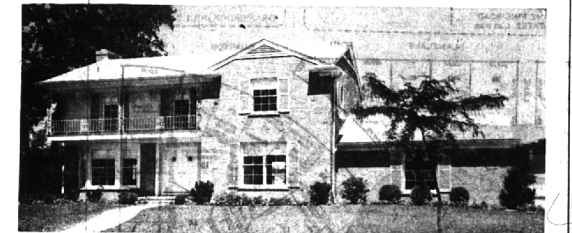

Permits for new buildings and alterations were 14 less and \$49,300 below last September, according to a report from Andrew F. Butt, building inspector for Birmingham.

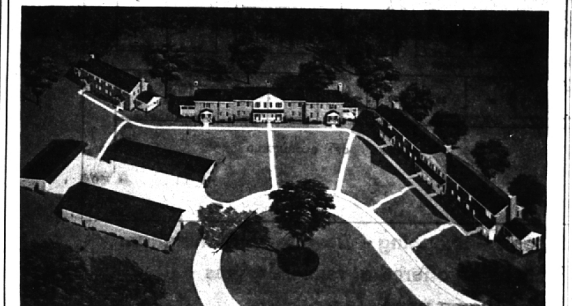
Twelve new structures were built last month, 25 were altered and one wrecked. Some 311 permits have been issued since the first of the year. Last year at this time, 349 permits were granted.

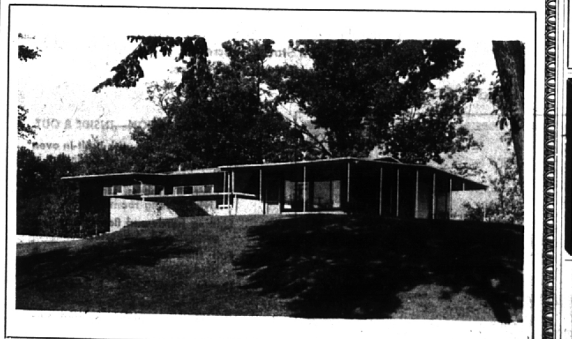
