Halloween Events Planned For Birmingham Tots, Teens

"The ghost to say the least," Halloween festivities in Birmingham Monday night include a wide variety of activities planned from the tot to teenage level.

Financed by local business and professional people and organized by local civic organizations, the agenda includes a parade-party in downtown Birmingham for preschoolers and elementary students. Seasholm and Groves high schools will hold dances and Barnum and Derby junior high schools will also have dances in addition to games and movies.

The parade will form at 7 p.m. at the Hill building on Chester street. Led by the Seasholm high school marching band, under the direction of Arnold Berndt, the parade will start north to Maple at 7:30, turn east on Maple to Woodward and then head south on Woodward for a block where food lines will be set up. Pets are not allowed in the parade.

Disc Jockey Shelby Newhouse will spin records for students who live in the Barnum junior high school area. Movies and games with prizes are also planned. Barnum student council is planning the evening under the direction of its sponsor, instructor William Labb. Muriel Brasie, girl counselor, is general chairman.

Public, private and parochial school students from Birmingham are invited. Tickets are available at all schools or the Birmingham chamber of commerce office. Tickets and refreshments are free.

DERBY - AREA students will dance to the four-piece band of Danny Baker from 7:30 to 10:30 p.m. Movies and games are also scheduled. The Derby staff, students and PTA are cooperating in the organization of the party.

DANCES FOR HIGH SCHOOL students will be held at both Groves and Seasholm. Jan Harris, Seasholm senior, is chairman of the 9 p.m. to midnight event planned in the Maple room. Music will be furnished by a four-piece band under the direction of student, Fred Greenleaf. Cider and Machus cakes and candies will be served.

The Robert DuRant six-piece band will play for dancers who attend the 7 to 10 p.m. dances at Groves high school. Movies and games will also be held simultaneously. The Groves cider and donuts will be served. Harold Newcomb, assistant principal, is in charge of the event.

Townships, Cities Will Spread Tax Roll for 1960

The Oakland county board of supervisors has authorized townships and cities within the county to spread the tax rolls for the year 1960 for their portion of the county general fund tax for the year 1961. The total to be raised for the county is \$1,007,232.67.

The county's portion is based on the county's 1960 adjusted equalized valuation of \$2,008,619,100 and represents a .545 mills per \$1,000 of equalized valuation.

LOCAL ASSESSING OFFICERS were also authorized to levy, within the 15 mill limitation, for 1960, funds totaling \$58,553,250.54. Of this, a total of \$45,867,640.07 goes for schools; \$59,274.06 for drains and \$1,619,091.14 to municipalities, plus the county's share.

The figures for municipalities do not include taxes against property that are spread in home rule cities under charter provision for either operating or voted increases.

Bloomfield township's share of the over-all figure is \$3,806,809.11; Southfield township will pay \$1,357,809.10 and West Bloomfield township will be taxed \$1,020,072.46.

Southfield leads the cities in the Birmingham area with a total tax of \$3,978,853.19 with Birmingham paying \$2,749,106.12. Bloomfield Hills will be taxed \$569,412.10; Troy will pay \$1,722,813.19 and Lathrup's share will be \$422,583.22.

IN OTHER action taken at the meeting, the board approved the Huron river sewage disposal system.
