Educators, Social Workers to Meet

Birmingham's school district and social agencies have received invitations to participate in a conference of some 300 Oakland county educators and social agency workers in Waterford Nov. 17.

This will be the first such conference in the county. A day-long meeting is being planned to enable 30 school districts, 65 agencies and 32 tax-supported groups "to better understand the functions of each agency in their relationship to educational problems of children."

JOINT SPONSORS are the Oakland county school superintendents' association and the school planning

division of United Community Services, through its two Oakland branches.

Donald C. Baldwin, Rochester school superintendent, is general chairman of the conference.

He said the meeting "will help participating groups increase their knowledge and understanding of the philosophies, purposes, and techniques of the other groups."

Although the responsibility of a judge professionally does not include certain executive decisions, I will always defend the policy of endeavoring to solve civic problems as close to the voters' homes as possible. The farther government gets from local controls, the more uncontrollable it becomes. That's why I oppose the growing tendency to allow society's problems to go to Washington for solution."
