## Pennypinchers' Tintype

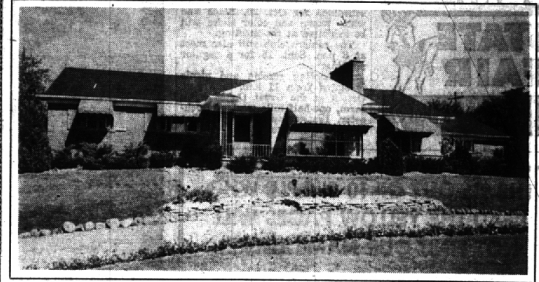
