

Sentence on One Delays Hearing On Second Charge

SOUTHFIELD—Examination of James Smith, 24500 Lahar, charged with negligent homicide in the July 5 death of David B. Neilson, 21446 Aron Lane, was postponed Friday. Smith, 29, is serving 90 days in the Detroit house of

correction on an assault and battery charge. He was convicted of the latter charge in Detroit last week. Neilson, 19, died following a July 4 accident in which a car, owned by Darrell Ashley, 19, 23465

Lee Baker, and driven by Smith, crashed into a tree. The accident occurred on Franklin road near 11 Mile. Both Ashley and Smith, as well as Michael Bockhurst, 19, another passenger, were injured. The four youths were all Southfield residents.

Because of Ashley's condition and refusal of Bockhurst and Smith to talk, Southfield police were at first unable to establish the identity of the driver. The youths were removed from the car before the arrival of the police. Investigation later identified Smith as the driver. All the youths had been drinking, police said.

SMITH was arraigned July 5 before Municipal Judge Clarence Reid Jr. of Southfield and released on \$500 bond. In the assault case, he and another youth were accused of pulling a man out of a phone booth and kicking him in the face. Southfield may ask for a writ releasing Smith from the house of correction to stand examination.

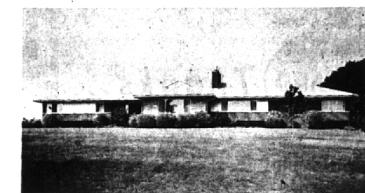

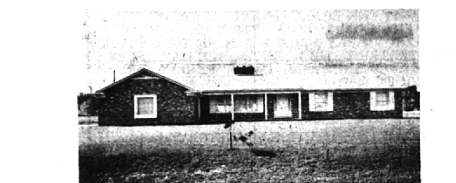
