## Official Will Attend Nuclear Orientation

LaBrecque, Wing Commander of Selfridge, and a detailed briefing of nuclear accidents by Colonel Wallace Frank, Deputy Wing Commander for Operations. The program will conclude with an actual "broken arrow" or simulated peacetime nuclear accident on the flight line.

## Vaughan School 6th Grade Class Presents Exhibit

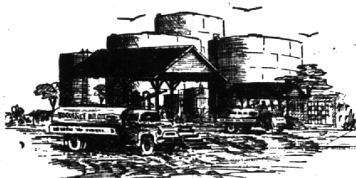
