**Qualified Democrats Wanted as Delegates**

"Not many qualified men can afford to take the necessary time off from their careers to be constitutional convention delegates," Michigan Democratic Committee Chairman John A. (Joe) Collins said Tuesday.

He spoke to 120 members of the Birmingham and Bloomfield Democratic clubs at a joint meeting at Birmingham Community House, where he predicted it would be difficult for political parties to find well-qualified men and women available to be convention delegates. He estimated that delegates would be serving for the maximum seven and a half months during which legislation provides them with a \$1,000 monthly salary.

BUT HE stressed that it was important for Michigan Democrats to list Con-Con candidates "of the highest ability and integrity" on July 25 election ballots.

"Only with well-qualified Democratic party delegates serving can we emphasize the party's principles and philosophies at the constitutional convention," Collins said.

Discussing education, the newly-elected successor to Neil Staebler censured the move to raise tuitions at state universities. He called for higher appropriations to the colleges to make tuition boosts unnecessary.

His appearance here was the first in Oakland County since his election as State Central Committee Chairman in February. A resident of Jackson, Collins is a 25-year-old insurance man.
