Scholarship Fund Mounts For MSUO

More than \$24,000 has been raised by the Michigan State University Oakland Foundation Scholarship Committee in its current drive.

This is almost half the \$40,000 goal the citizens group set for itself this year—a \$20,000 increase over last year's goal.

THE FUND will provide scholarships for 160-30 more than last year—and help keep the pledge made by MSUO Chancellor D. B. Varner that no high school senior in the top quarter of his class would be denied the opportunity to attend college for lack of money.

Director of the drive is Mrs. Maxwell Matthews, 1627 Kirkway, Bloomfield Hills, chairman of the committee. A similar group in Macomb County is under the chairmanship of Mrs. Philip T. Muligan of Mr. Clemens.

Mrs. Matthews said that gifts, ranging from a few dollars to several hundreds, are coming from individuals, civic and private groups and business and industry.

POINTING OUT that MSUO has no alumni, Mrs. Matthews said the entire community has a responsibility to students who qualify for college but cannot afford to go.

"Many young persons do not have money for college even though they are living at home," she said.

Accepting the committee's first report this week, Chancellor Varner gave tribute to this group of 28 wives and mothers "who have given so much of their time and energy to support the promise I made to this community."

Coast Guard Offers Safe Boat Handling 8-Lesson Course

The course begins at 7 p. m. tonight at the Highland Park High School, Room B, First Floor. This is an eight-lesson course.

Completion of the course given by the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary, qualifies persons for the Michigan State Waterways Commission Watercraft Operators Certificate. It is also the last chance to take this course on safe boat handling before the commencement of the 1961 boating season.
