Days Fly Fast Aboard Cruise Ship to Hawaii

ABOARD SS LURLINE (At Sea)—What do you do on a ship all day? Sit around in a deck chair with a good book, waiting for the day to be announced for the trip. Not likely. At least, not aboard this luxury liner. Of course, the fact that you're bound for the happy, colorful port of Honolulu has a lot to do with the prevailing party spirit. (As you're sure to discover if you accompany the ship's Suburbia Sea Party sponsored by Suburbia Today this spring.)

Outlining the day's shipboard activities each morning is "The Polynesian," the ship's newspaper, which also reports important world news, compiled by radio and edited by the chief purser.

THE LISTING of activities generally covers at least 38 different events, running from 7 a.m. (early riser's coffee) right through to midnight (dancing).

A native Hawaiian cruise hostess and cruise host help keep the activities moving at a merry clip. Surprisingly, aboard a ship you find you can get by on a very few hours' sleep and still feel miraculously rested; almost as if you'd been in a health camp.

On your mid-morning promenade, you're bound to encounter a steward with clip board in hand, selling tickets for the daily mileage pool. A day's run on a ship is measured from noon to noon. You win if the number you choose happens to be the last digit in the 11 page scored in the next 24 hours.

ANOTHER FAVORITE of many passengers, young and old, is the daily horse racing.

Excitement is as highly pitched here, as at Santa Anita or Suffolk Downs. The "horserace" (two or three ones, about a foot high) move according to the toss of dice in a variety of ways.

None of the six races is run just alike. Some take four dice, some take two. The first may require two hurdles, a double to jump and a double to finish, to win; the last likely to be a mule race, with a single to start and a double to finish, and the last mule is the winner.

It's pari-mutuel betting, and it's all explained in your score card. But one thing for sure—you need know nothing about real horse racing to participate.

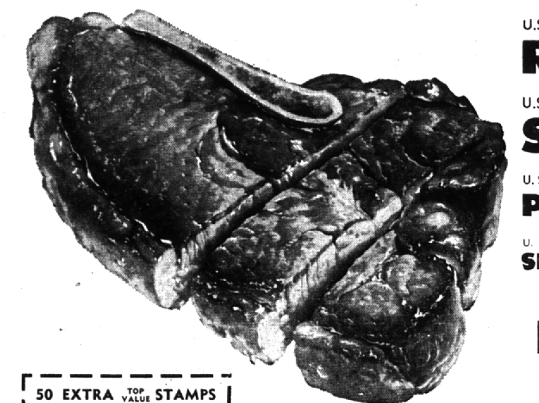
