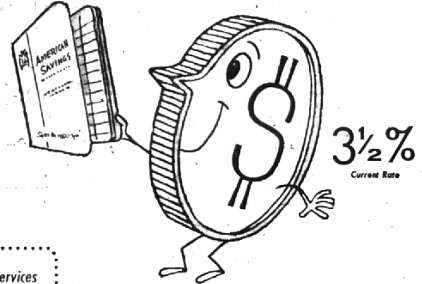
While seated at the piano, Lawrence will lecture, illustrating his points informally at the keyboard.

Dr. Wehli is the former pastor of Detroit's Ward Memorial Presbyterian Church and Wheaton College Alumnus.

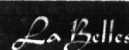
