Stolen from the new, partially furnished home, were two bar stools and a light fixture. Entry was made through a window.

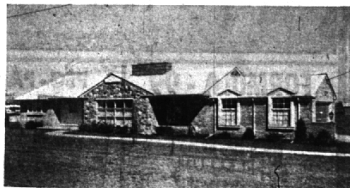
Pottario was put on one year's probation and fined \$35 or 10 days.

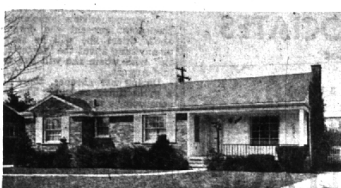

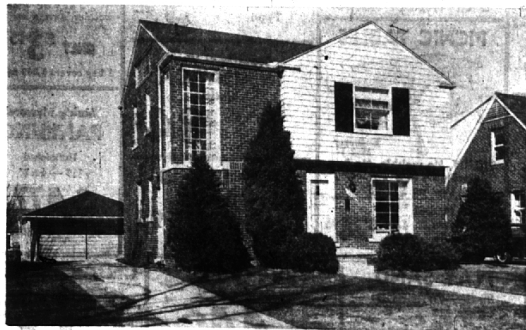

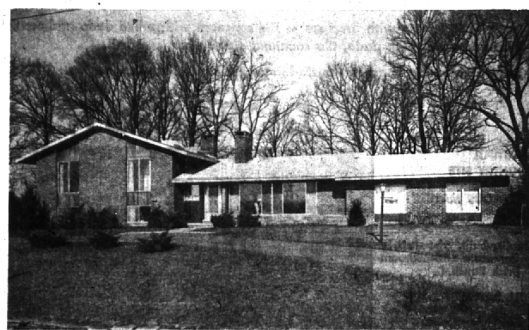
