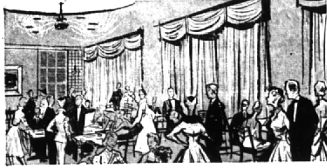

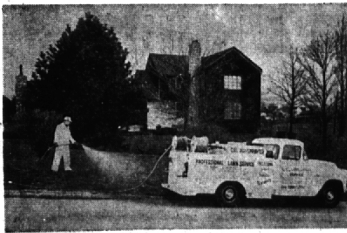

And that he is apparently interested in seeing Spain's return to a state of limited monarchy, but not until after his own death.

"We like Spain, and we want to go back some day," Ball said.

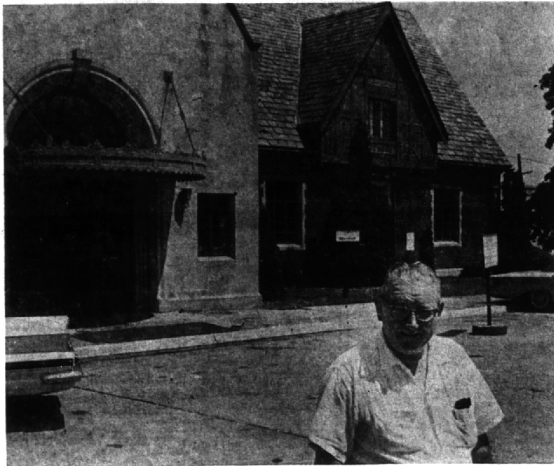

The opening of commuter service, between Detroit and Pontiac, on Aug. 1, 1931, was preceded by weeks of preparation for a gala celebration. Some 50,000 North Woodward area residents and

local and state officials attended the ceremonies. Two parades, band concerts, banquets, athletic contests and street fairs sparked the steady 15-hour program. The station cost \$125,000 to construct; cost of the new right-of-way, from Pontiac to Royal Oak, was \$8 million.

WHAT DOCTORS SAY ABOUT

- Contact Lenses
- Wine and Gout

Q. Will the wearing of contact lenses prevent further nearsightedness?
A. So far as we know there have been no accurate statistical studies which prove or disprove the claim that contact lenses stop the progress of nearsightedness. Ophthalmologists (M.D.'s) who specialize in eye disorders have observed that contact lenses rarely need changing within a 4- to 5-year period. This may be due to a molding effect of the lens on the cornea. Whether this ever results in permanent eye change for the better hasn't been proved.

Q. Does the drinking of wine cause gout?
A. Not according to a San Francisco doctor. Medical histories of 200 gout patients showed no connection between the disease and the drinking of wine. Gout is an hereditary disorder due to a supposed abnormality in excretion of uric acid by the kidneys. Gouty attacks may last a few days to a few weeks. Usually one joint is involved, the great toe being most commonly affected.
