## Health Department To X-Ray Only Persons Over 30

By this fall, the Michigan Department of Health expects to be X-raying only persons 30 or more years old with their traveling mobile X-ray units.

PLANS ARE BEING developed so that persons under 30 will be skin tested for TB at the same time older persons are being X-rayed by mobile units. Dr. Isahar said those positive skin tests will be notified to report for a

chest X-ray and other tests necessary to confirm or rule out active tuberculosis.

ABOUT TWO and one-half per cent of the school children and 20 per cent of the state's adult population are TB reactors, according to Dr. Isahar.

Other mobile X-ray unit findings show that 98 per cent of the heart abnormalities and 81 per cent of suspected lung tumors discovered occurred in persons over 30 years of age.

THE 30-YEARS-OLD limit will be effective at once in areas where mobile X-ray unit appearances have not yet been announced.

## Report of Highway Needs Presented by Committee

The most comprehensive Highway Needs Study ever made in Michigan was unveiled Tuesday.

THE THREE-YEAR study was made by the State Highway Department in cooperation with the County Road Association of Michigan and the Michigan Municipal League, County Road Commissions, 510 incorporated cities and villages. The U.S. Bureau of Public Roads also participated.

Highways 1950-1960—based on an engineering evaluation of 110,000 miles of state highways, county roads and city and village streets.

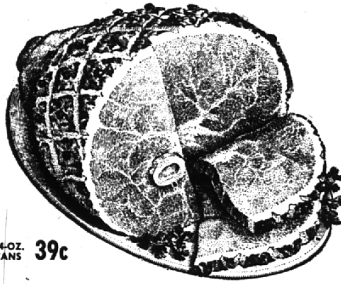
