Back from a pleasant two weeks at Elk Lake near Traverse City is the Joseph Farmer family of Lauderdale.

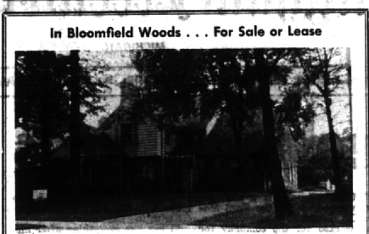
