**Set Kindergarten Enrollment Date In B'field Hills**

Attention, parents of Bloomfield Hills kindergarten children: Kindergarten children who have not previously enrolled may do so in the respective school offices during the last two weeks in August. A birth or baptismal certificate is required.

All children should have their physical examinations and immunizations before entering school. These forms may be obtained in the school office.

**KINDERGARTEN** classes will start Sept. 11. During the week of Sept. 11-15, the morning group will meet for one hour from 9 to 10 a.m. and the afternoon group from 1 to 2 p.m.

After that a regular day schedule will be followed for all Kindergarten children. Principals will meet with parents on the first day for the one hour the children are in their rooms. At this time the Kindergarten program will be discussed.

**PARENTS OF** children in Kindergarten, first and second grades are asked to see that the first two or three days children riding the bus have a note pinned on them giving: name, address, telephone number and the bus number.

**B'ham System Adds to Staff For Handicapped**

Improved services for handicapped students will be possible during the coming year, according to Bernard Maslanik, Coordinator of Special Services for the Birmingham Public Schools.

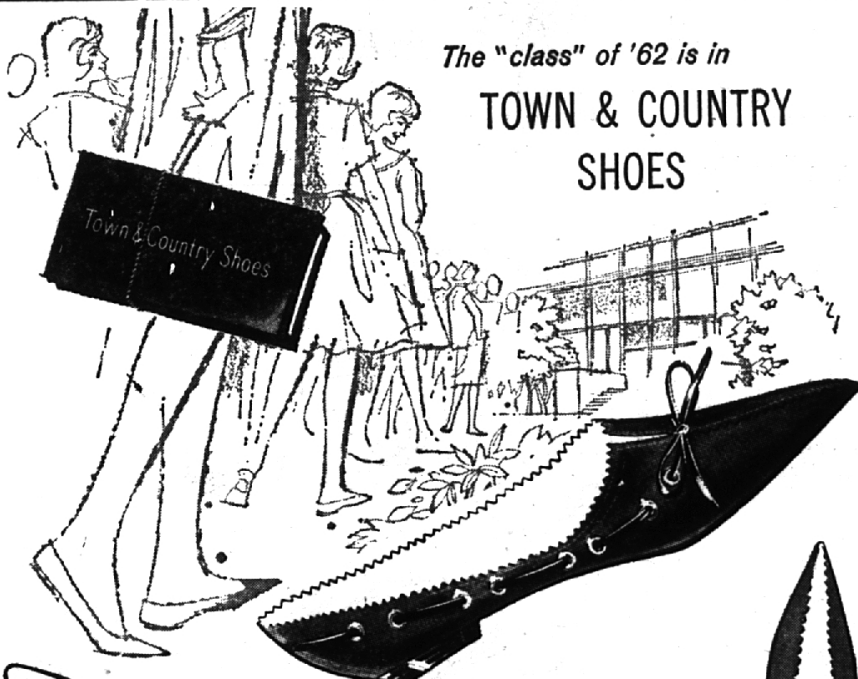
One visiting teacher, three speech correctionists and two nurses have been hired to bring each staff up to five. One diagnostician will be available to provide psychological testing services.

All costs of additions to the special education staff, except those to the nursing staff, are met by the state and the county, according to Maslanik.

**THE SPECIAL** Education program for mentally handicapped elementary school children has been moved from Valley Woods School to Baldwin School. This was made necessary because of the shift in attendance area boundaries between Walnut Lake and Valley Woods Schools, according to Daniel Nesbitt, Deputy Superintendent.

A special education room will be opened at Groves Junior-Senior High to provide services for mentally handicapped high school age students.

The adjusted study program for elementary and junior high school age boys will continue at the Pierce cottage schools.
