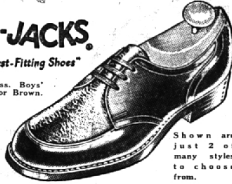

**State Heritage
Dates to 1622:
Trace History**

It's great to live in Michigan because of our rich heritage and outstanding historic landmarks. This heritage dates to 1622—only two years after the Pilgrims landed at Plymouth Rock—when the first French voyageurs crossed out of French Canada across Lake Huron and discovered the Upper Peninsula. Detroit, hub of the auto industry, itself bears a French name which means "The Straits," for here were located the straits between Lakes Erie and St. Clair, a crossroads of Indian trade and wars. Settled by Sieur Cadillac in 1701, it has been a key crossroads ever since. Other French settlements were at St. Ignace, Sault Ste. Marie, Benton Harbor and Niles. When the British won their war against the French in 1763, they took over these forts—and the rich fur trade. These they held until 1796.

IT WAS NOT until after the War of 1812 that Michigan settlement began in earnest. Toll roads, then railroads sprang up. Most of the historic early toll roads, many of them former Indian trails, were to become major highways, such as US-12 and US-16. Pioneering was continuing when the Civil War erupted in 1861. Michigan's lumbering industry, and its new iron and copper mines were in demand. When the conflict ended in 1865, these products boomed, and Michigan began to make its mark as a manufacturing state, since the Great Lakes and its shipping provided easy access to raw materials. This happy combination of factors, plus Yankee ingenuity, played a part in the establishment of the auto industry in Detroit. Flint, Pontiac and Lansing, Great educational institutions, landmarks in themselves, have now entered the Atomic Age to assure that the needs of Michigan industry will continue to be met.

**AF Promoted Snyder
To Reserve Major**

Ben M. Snyder III, assistant headmaster at Cranbrook School, has been promoted to the rank of major in the United States Air Force reserves. The promotion was announced by Lt. Col. John L. Underwood, commander of the 9019th Air Reserve Squadron, headquartered in Pontiac. Major Snyder is an 18-year veteran of the Air Force and served as a bombardier during World War II. He flew 41 combat missions during a tour of duty in the South Pacific 1944-45. On one of these missions, he led the first heavy bomber drop on Corregidor following MacArthur's return to the Philippine Islands in 1945. He holds a number of military decorations, including the air medal with seven clusters and the Distinguished Flying Cross.

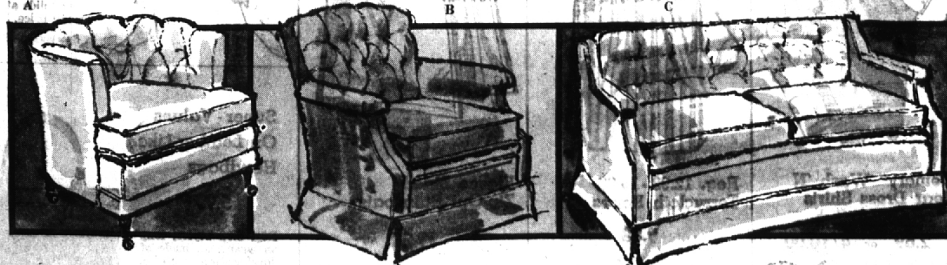
