Lathrup Approves Sewer Ordinance; Establishes Rates

LATHRUP - Ordinance No. 67, providing for operation and maintenance of the sanitary sewer system, was passed by council Monday night.

IN ADDITION, a \$3 quarterly charge per 1,000 square feet of horizontal surface drained by downspouts will be paid by owners of buildings whose downspouts are allowed to remain connected.
