**Motorcycles  
Invade Area  
For Races**

Tom Compton, 1409 Holland, Birmingham, will carry the city's colors Sunday in Michigan's first paved road race for motorcycles at the Waterford Hills course of the Oakland County Sportsman's Road Racing Club.

Drivers from throughout the country will appear in the series of races at 1:30 p.m.

Every size machine from seven to 74 cubic-inch displacement, with drivers in both amateur and expert classes, will see action on the course's hills and hairpin turns.

ROAD RACING for motorcycles is extremely popular in Europe but has been relatively new to American enthusiasts.

Race action includes tire burning, acceleration, pin-point steering and crash braking.

The Waterford course is a mile-and-a-half around and was developed primarily for sports car racing. Spectator vantage points offer panoramic views of the entire road-racing circuit.

Main event will feature the fastest drivers from each class in a 50-mile final.

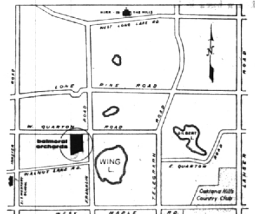
