\$1.5 Million In Bonds; So What?

"Here we are considering a one-and-a-half-million-dollar bond issue and no one here to protest or approve," a Birmingham city commissioner commented Monday night.

The commission was acting on a resolution to authorize issuance of fund bonds to pay the City's share of the Twelve Towns Drain. "Let us propose to cut down eight trees or ban parking and we'll have a full house," commented another commissioner. They referred to the fact that

there was only one person in the audience besides city department heads who attend every commission meeting. The resolution passed unanimously.

IN EFFECT, the City will pay in advance its entire assessment—\$1,963,857.51—of the \$47.5 million relief drain for southern Oakland County.

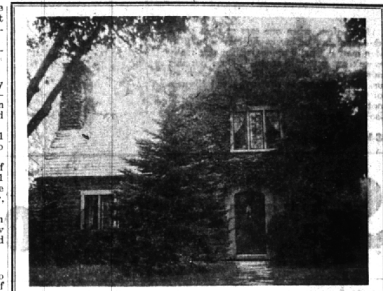
The City will take \$463,857.51 from the General Fund to add to the \$1.5 million from the bonds.

The bonds, in denominations of \$1,000 each, will be dated Oct. 1 and will bear interest at a rate not to exceed five percent per year, payable semiannually.

The 20-year general obligation bonds will mature on the first day of October beginning in 1982 and running through 1981.

BEFORE SETTING a date to accept sealed bids for purchase of the bonds, the City will have to gain permission from the Michigan Municipal Finance Commission to issue the bonds.

Birmingham's tax rate will increase next July due to the Twelve Towns Drains assessment.
