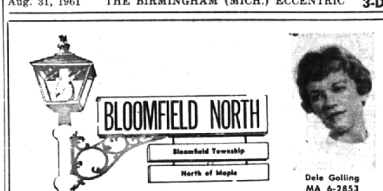
**BARBARA ANN BREIEN
