

### Negotiate to Buy Land for Village

**BEVERLY HILLS**—The village will offer \$30,000 to William Gilmore for a 150 x 400-ft. parcel of property east of the present village headquarters, according to a report made Monday by Councilman Chester F. Guilmet. The council instructed Village Attorney Thomas J. Dillon Jr. to negotiate with Gilmore to acquire the land.

A TOTAL OF 60,000 square feet is in the parcel. Beverly Hills is presently renting office space in the Southfield Township Hall, 18500 W. 13 Mile Road.

**WOOD CREEK FARMS**—An ordinance to protect the growth of trees and provide for the removal of diseased trees, a protest against a township "tax to collect taxes" and a request for reflector signs at the council meeting Tuesday night.

The tree ordinance, prepared by council woman Norma Linn, decrees that all dead trees, regardless of specie, constitute a breeding place for disease and must be removed or burned within a 10-day period following official notification to the property owners.

**PERIODIC** investigations will be made by duly authorized village representatives of trees on public and private property. Samples of trees suspected of disease will be tested by forestry experts.

Property owners will be notified by registered letter and will have 10 days to remove the nuisance, by contract with the village or by private means. Failure to comply with the ordinance may mean a fine of \$100 or 30 days imprisonment, or both, at the discretion of the court.

Ordinance number 11 becomes effective 20 days after posting.

**VILLAGE CLERK** Mrs. Everett Billa reported that there are 159 registered voters in Wood Creek Farms. Since incorporation in 1958, 39 have moved or died. There are a great many residents still unregistered, she said.

A polling place for the March 12 election is sought. Two councilmen will be elected, as well as a clerk, treasurer and assessor. Petitions must be filed by Feb. 10, president Norman Krieder stated.

State election inspectors have reminded Mrs. Billa that both parties must be represented in the application for election personnel. In past elections, only Republican women have volunteered to serve at the polls.
