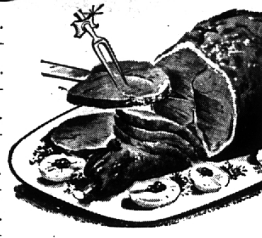
**Woodworth Wins 2nd Soccer Letter**
