Letter Defines Road Rules In Lathrup
LATHRUP—A deadline of April 1, 1962, has been set for filing petitions for street paving next year, the city reminded residents in its latest newsletter. Petition forms may be obtained from City Clerk Frank Derby at the city hall.
Seventy per cent of the property owners must sign any petition. Assessments may be paid in full without interest or in five installments with six per cent interest on the unpaid balance, the newsletter stated.
THE LETTER also spelled out standards for new road construction as well as road resurfacing. New roads must be constructed of concrete. Surfaces must be, in order of preference, concrete, asphalt over concrete base or gravel surface.
Dust control measures and temporary stabilization of gravel road surfaces are limited to seal coat surfacing, chemical treatment or waste oil surfacing, in that order.
THE CITY ALSO asked cooperation in its letter, in the elimination of rocks, stones and other roadside barriers that may damage vehicles and city snow removal equipment.
The latter has already suffered damage from such a cause, the letter stated. Use of reflector-type signals was suggested to residents to prevent vehicles from driving on shoulders of property that is planted with grass.

Lathrup Sets Date For Annual Bonfire Of Christmas Trees
LATHRUP—The city will hold its annual Christmas tree bonfire on Jan. 6 at 5 p.m., the city announced in a newsletter this week. The bonfire will be held in the recreation area at Rainbow Drive and Southfield Road.
Trees will be collected at the roadside during the week prior to Jan. 6. A final pickup will start at noon on the day of the bonfire. Trees, branches and brush may be delivered to the bonfire site. Only Christmas trees will be collected by the city.

Ginn to Give Up County Dem Post To Take S'field Job
FRANKLIN—James M. Ginn, 3015 Woodside, Oakland County Democratic chairman, was appointed Southfield City Attorney Monday night. The appointment was approved by Southfield council.
Ginn will give up his political affiliations, including the chairmanship of the Oakland County Democratic party.
GINN REPLACES James C. Allen, city attorney for almost four years, who resigned Monday. Allen's resignation becomes effective Dec. 15.
Ginn's appointment followed a long battle by Southfield Mayor S. James Clarkson to appoint him to the job. Council has turned down the appointment three times in the past eight months on grounds that the job should be nonpartisan.
