**Sewer-Paving Project Decision Is Postponed**

There will be no decision at this time on a sewer-paving proposal for streets in the Holy Name Church area in Birmingham. City commissioners decided Monday night to consider the project along with others in the capital improvement program for 1962. They recinded their action of last week to set up special assessment district procedures. Plans call for the paving of Woodland from Harmon to Vinewood, Greenwood from Harmon to Vinewood and Harmon from Greenwood to Woodward.

Relief sewers are proposed for Harmon from Baldwin to Woodland and for Greenwood and Woodland about 300 feet north from Harmon.

CITY MANAGER L. R. Gare and City Engineer William T. Killen recommended the paving and sewers. Present sewers, though causing no trouble now, are inadequate from a design standpoint, they said, and relief sewers should be constructed if the streets are to be paved.

One of the problems facing the commission is whether to assess property owners for part of the sewer costs or to charge the entire cost to the city-at-large. Sewers were constructed and property owners assessed for them in 1941.

Killen estimated costs of the sewers at \$16,000 and of the paving at \$54,700 and \$64,600, depending on width.

COMMISSIONER Charles Renfrew suggested that the project be considered as part of the capital improvement program. To Commissioner William H. Burgum, this was "sound thinking."

**National Guard Joins In Holiday Patrols**

Vigilant care in driving and walking during the holidays can bring Michigan the reward of a reduction in traffic deaths this year, Commissioner Joseph A. Childs said in announcing that State Police will operate intensified road patrols during the 78-hour Christmas and New Year's weekends.

Barring an upsurge in fatal accidents, Michigan has a chance to end 1961 with one per cent fewer deaths than the 1,596 of last year, he said. This would be a saving of 16 lives, a nip and tuck result for the year, but nevertheless a gain. The saving could be even slightly more.
