The board of directors of the Oakland County Branch of the Michigan Children's Aid Society honored its executive director Oriol Endelman on her retirement at a reception Friday.

Charles Mentzer, chairman of the Oakland County chapter of the National Association of Social Workers, presented an inscribed plaque to Miss Endelman in recognition of her many years in the field of social work.

WHEN MISS Endelman first came to the Oakland County branch 27 years ago, there were no other staff workers as there were but five or six children under care.

In 1934, she shared an office in the basement of Pontiac General Hospital with the Pontiac police woman. In 1961, the staff of seven social workers, two part-time social workers and three clerks are comfortably housed in the Community Services Building.

BORN IN Aigona, Miss Endelman drives to work each day from her home in Marine City. She is a graduate of the University of Michigan with a degree in social work.

Homemaking Tips

Pouring cold water on a hot broiler pan may cause it to warp or crack.

Allow the porcelain on your stove to cool before washing it with a mild soap or detergent and water to avoid crazing.

Shiny coat collars can usually be nicely dulled by sponging with a cloth wrung out of hot vinegar. Press the collar on wrong side while still damp.

When cutting marshmallows, use a pair of thoroughly clean scissors dipped in hot water to prevent the marshmallows from sticking together.

Keep fudge frosting soft and workable while using, by placing dish in a pan of hot water.
