Interest, Dividend Reminder Issued By Internal Revenue

The Internal Revenue Service today issued a reminder to all taxpayers that all interest and dividends, whether paid directly to you or credited to your account, must be included on your income tax return.

R. I. Nixon, district director of Internal Revenue, stated that there are certain exclusions and credits which will reduce the tax liability

on dividends. The director added that taxpayers should check the instruction booklet and follow carefully the schedule on the return to make sure that the benefits are claimed correctly. DIRECTOR NIXON stressed that before signing and filing your return, you should make sure that: 1. Your name and address is printed plainly. 2. All income is properly reported. 3. All allowable deductions are claimed.

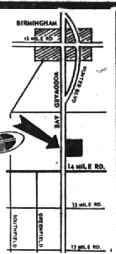

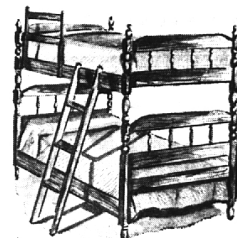

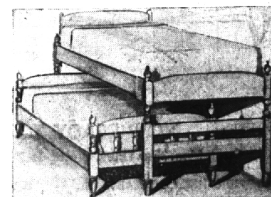
