

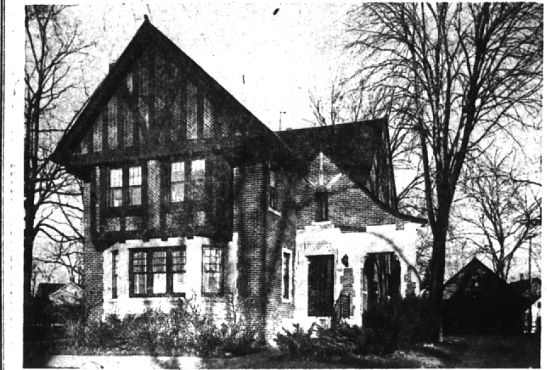
**Local Women Will Attend Convention**
