**Computing Machine
Is Also Chivalrous**

Age guessing has long been a favorite pastime, but there is a new space computer—called a digital computer—that takes all the guesswork out of it.

BUT THE LADIES—be they over 21—needn't worry; for this computer, which will be on exhibit at Cranbrook Institute of Science Feb. 8 through March 15, guards their secret well.

When given the correct answers to 10 questions, this computer, developed by Delco Radio Division of General Motors, will accurately announce a man's age.

ON A SIX-FOOT case which surrounds the tiny computer (It's one inch thick and 6 by 12 inches in area) are a series of push buttons requiring a "yes" or "no" answer to the 10 questions. Using circuit logic the computer can calculate and report the age in seconds.

But there is a Question 11 and here's where chivalry steps in. "Are you female?"

If there is an affirmative answer, the computer first ascertains she is no longer a teen-ager and then bows in gentlemanly fashion.

IN THE AGE window of the exhibit pops an automatic "21".
