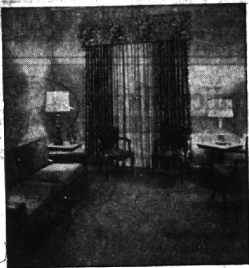


Pharmacy Club To Hold Dinner
