Commission Asks Widening Of Rochester

Troy City Commission launched a proposed plan to widen Rochester Road Monday night by asking the State Highway Department to take a traffic count on the two-lane road between 16 Mile (Big Beaver) and 20 Mile (South Boulevard).

The count is intended to establish the need for widening.

The commission also requested that the Highway Department meet with the commission soon to discuss the project.

Proposed plans call for Rochester Road to be four lanes from 16 Mile north because of traffic generated by the planned Chrysler Expressway which crosses Rochester road at 16 Mile.

ACCORDING TO COMMISSIONER Vanich who made

the proposal, a Highway Department traffic count last year on Rochester north of 16 Mile showed that an average of 16,700 cars passed per hour over a three-day period.

Vanich reminded the commission that the Oakland County Road Commission advised some time ago that an average of over 10,000 cars an hour was sufficient grounds for widening to four lanes.

The Highway Department has expressed its willingness to widen Rochester to five lanes from the Chrysler interchange for about 1,200 feet north to 16 Mile.

The traffic jam which could possibly result at 16 Mile because of the drop from five to two lanes prompted the commission's action.

ANOTHER REASON behind the request was the Highway Department's announced plans to make 21 Mile (Avon Road) an east-west expressway. The commission insists this will further increase Rochester Road traffic heading from the Chrysler to northern Macomb County.

Ten per cent of the widening of 1,200 feet of Rochester north from the Chrysler interchange to 16 Mile will be paid by the county and Troy while 90 per cent will be financed by the Federal government and the state.

However, the Federal government will only pay 50 per cent of the widening of the rest of Rochester with the state, county and Troy paying the balance.
