BEVERLY HILLS—Village officials Monday night set March 20 as a hearing date for the rezoning of 33 acres of property on the northwest corner of Southfield and 13 Mile Road.

THE MARCH 20 hearing, scheduled to start at 8 p. m., will be held to hear views on zoning property along Southfield Road to B-2 (commercial) and the 13 Mile Road territory to R-1 (non-retail, professional). Interior lanes would be zoned R-2 for residential use.
