TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SAID SCHOOL DISTRICT PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a Special School Election will be held in said School District on Monday, January 30,

Act 269, Public Acts of Michigan, 1955 as amended, pro-vides in part as follows:

"The Inspectors of Election at any annual or special election shall not receive the vote of any person residing in a registration school district whose name is not registered as an elector in the city or township in which he resides . . . "

THE LAST DAY on which persons may register with the appropriate city or township clerks of the city or township in which they reside in order to be eligible to vote at said Special Election is Friday, January 20, 1961. Persons reg-istering ofter 5:00 o'clock p.m., Eastern Standard Time on said Friday, January 20, 1961, will not be eligible to vote at said Special School Election.

Under the provisions of Act 269, Public Acts of M 1955, as amended, registrations will not be taken by school officials, and only persons who have registered as general electors with the appropriate city or township clerks of the city or township in which they reside are registered school electors. Persons planning to register with city or township clerks must ascertain the days and hours on which the clerks for office is open for registration.
