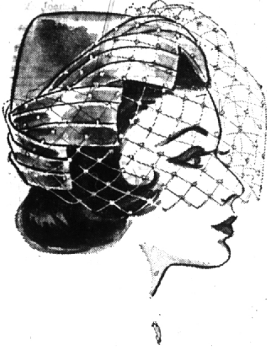

**Noted Fabric Designer To Present One-Man Show**

Noted fabric designer Marianne Strengell will be honored at a reception Sunday from 4 to 6 p.m. at Kingswood School Cranbrook. The reception will open her one-man show of fabrics, rugs and photography which will be open to the public at Kingswood through Feb. 10.



Miss Strengell is head of the department of weaving and textile design at Cranbrook Academy of Art. While Kingswood presents her work this month, fabrics by Miss Strengell are being featured in a ten-man invitational show of artist-craftsmen at the Brooklyn, N. Y., Museum of Art.
