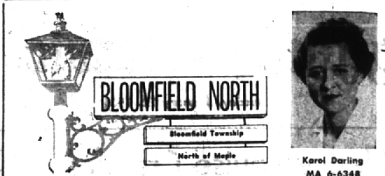




To Live In Washington
