Study of Flood Plain Zoning Asked in B'ham

Birmingham's legal counsel ruled this week that the City can adopt flood plain zoning. Commissioners decided Monday night to refer the matter to the city plan board and the city manager's office for study and recommendation.

Commissioner Ralph A. Main, proponent of flood plain zoning for all of Oakland County, said that all Birmingham needs is an amendment to the present zoning ordinance and a flood control map. He said Clinton Township in Macomb County has such a law that is proving successful.
