Report Increases In Water Mishaps

Alarming increases in the number of water deaths, injuries and accidents in Michigan this far this year, with nearly half of the summer season of water sports activity still to go, are reported by the State Police.

Provisional totals, based on reports by all police agencies through July 10, show 162 dead and 94 injured in 208 water accidents. In the comparable period last year 140 accidents claimed 74 lives and 74 injured.

This year's accidents were listed as 81 fatalities, 67 personal injury and 60 property damage only.

THE DEATH INCLUDED 26 swimmers or waders, 28 who fell from bridges, banks, docks or piers, 17 boat passengers, 10 boat operators, seven who fell through ice, four who drowned trying to rescue others, and one skin diver.

Navy League Organizing Cadet Corps

The Southeastern Michigan Council of the Navy League is calling all handy young men, ages 14 to 17, and their fathers, to establish units of the U. S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps, the first in Michigan.

A meeting for the Birmingham, Bloomfield Hills area is held at the Pontiac Naval Reserve Training Center, 469 East Boulevard South, every Monday evening from 7 to 9 o'clock. Membership requires parents' consent.

Membership in the Corps does not commit the boy to become a member of the Naval Forces at a later date. However, if he does decide to enter any one of the varied U. S. Navy educational programs, either on the college officer level, or the trade enlisted level, the training received as a cadet will enhance his eligibility and performance.

THE SEA CADET program is designed to bring new interests and friendships to the boy. It aims at teaching a code of personal honor and chivalry based upon the best traditions of the sea. Thus, its primary purpose is to prepare boys for useful citizenship by developing character, self-discipline, and an appreciation for the American heritage.

The organization and method of Sea Cadet training are based upon sound Naval procedure. Training at weekly, two-hour meetings includes such subjects as seamanship,

Ten Residents Named To Con-Con Committee

Oakland County Republicans lined up to Con-Con business Monday as a special research and education committee made up of 10 Birmingham residents swung into action.

County GOP Chairman Arthur G. Elliott Jr. appointed Malcom R. Lovell, 2748 Amberly, Birmingham, American Motors Corp. executive, to chair the 40-member committee.

Other Birmingham committeemen are William H. Baldwin, 745 Huppcrest; Daniel Chapin, 601 Orchard Hill; S. F. Leahy, 500 Huppcrest; Thomas B. Adams, 931 W. ELLIOTT SAID he appointed leading citizens "who have demonstrated interest and competence in dealing with the complex problems facing the state" to assist Republican delegates and set up voter ed-

Elliott said the programs would be made available to any community group requesting them. "The committee will act solely in an advisory capacity," Elliott said. "No attempt will be made to impose opinions on either delegates or voters. We are primarily concerned with keeping the public informed on all alternative courses of action involved in each major Con-Con issue."

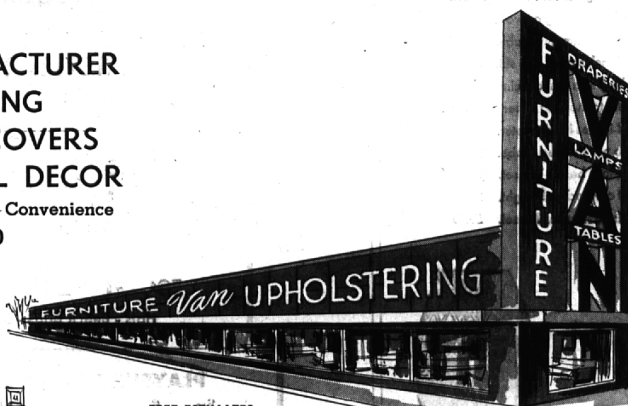
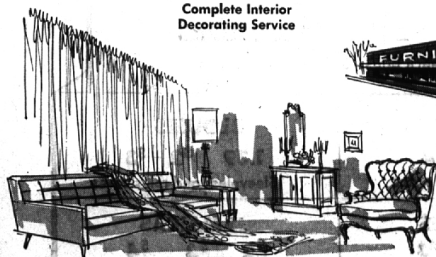
