'Blue Gold' is There For the 'Prospecting'

 Blueberries should be ready for picking in late July or early August. Just when the season will be at its berry pickin' heat will vary from area from area.

Wet, wooded lowlands will be the best places for picking in the southern lower peninsula, where the high bush or swamp blueberry is common.

POOR nonagricultural soils and certain undisturbed woodlots are usually good spots for your prospecting.

Blueberries are found in dry sandy plains or moist woods and swamps in the upper and northern lower peninsulas.
