and payable annually beginning April the next year.

THE BOARD set up this tentative schedule:

Receive construction bids Sept. 10-20 this year.

Award construction contracts by Oct. 9, subject to the sale and delivery of bonds.

Receive bids on bonds on or about Dec. 1.

Deliver bonds on or about Jan. 1, 1962.

The resolution approving the roll permits repayments of one or more installments on or before Nov. 1, but notice of intent to do so must be filed with the drain board on or before Oct. 1.

If Birmingham is to issue its own bonds, it will have to meet the Nov. 1 deadline.

PURKISS EXPLAINED that about one-third of Birmingham will
