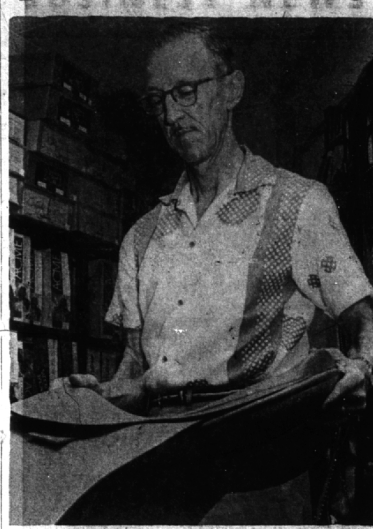

## Arizona Saddlery Has 'Horse Flavor'

Giddyup, pardner. Whoa there. There are a lot of horses around the Birmingham area, and they're "rarin'" to be outfitted. That's the job of Arizona Saddlery, 526 N. Woodward, Birmingham.

**AL PERRY**, manager of Arizona Saddlery and an old horse-lover himself, oversees a "ranch" of English and Western riding clothes, saddles, horse accessories, jewelry and paintings, boots, hats (the 10-gallon style), and Texas-style gifts.

"We handle just about anything for the horse or the horseman," said Perry. Arizona Saddlery opened last December and caters to people from the Bloomfield Open Hunt Club, Metamora Hunt Club, Croose Pointe Hunt Club, and Tom Outland's Riding Stable.

"And we get people from all over the state," Perry said.

**ARIZONA SADDLERY** purchases most of its leather goods from wholesalers, but does craft work for special orders. Perry, 18781 Bungalow, Lathrup Village, is a soft-spoken ex-missile man who turned to horses because he "likes them too well."

"That missile business is too rush-rush-rush," he said. Perry worked for Chrysler in the missile engineering and purchasing departments before turning to his first love.

**RAISED IN THE** Blue Grass country of Kentucky, Perry has been a rider most of his life. He owned his own horse until recently.
