

# Woodward-Hamilton, Maple-Bates Corners To Get New Signals

Birmingham city commissioners Monday night authorized installation of a traffic-pedestrian signal at Hamilton and Woodward and installation of new pedestrian signals at Maple and Bates.

Both were recommended by police Chief Ralph W. Moxley.

All Woodward signals will be interconnected between Brown and Willis, it was also decided.

Cost of the Woodward-Hamilton light is estimated at \$3,210, plus \$800 for the interconnection.

A POLICE department survey showed that from the vehicular traffic standpoint, no light was needed at the intersection.

However, from the pedestrian standpoint present conditions do warrant a light.

During the 12-hour survey 1,603 pedestrians crossed Woodward either east or west at the intersection. Another 1,125 crossed north or south through the inter-

## U-M Prof Sees Challenge for Jr. Colleges

ANN ARBOR — Community colleges face a growing challenge in technical terminal education, according to Alvo D. Henderson, director of The University of Michigan Center for the Study of Higher Education.

"American industry has been changing rapidly, technologically. It requires an ever increasing flow of young persons trained at the semi-professional level," says Henderson.

The U-M educator asserts that too much junior college technical training has invited professional schools on a water-gate-down basis of copied high school vocational courses with an upgrading in content.

HENDERSON NAMES four handicaps which junior colleges need to overcome:

- 1) Many of the courses that have been established have not been sufficiently founded upon data collected through occupational analysis.
- 2) In many instances inadequate

## provisions have been made for laboratory or other experience.

2) Nearly all institutions have experienced a dearth of teachers who are well trained to teach the particular specialization.

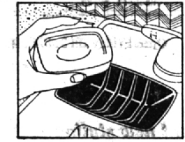
4) In some instances the senior colleges and universities have not had a good understanding of what the two-year colleges were endeavoring to do in this area and so have not given them encouragement and support.

"AT THE U-M," Henderson states, "we have been so convinced of the opportunity for service in this area, that as part of our new efforts to prepare junior community college administrators under the Kellogg Grant, we have employed a man of substantial experience in the technical terminal area, and are expecting to make a major effort to define more clearly the curriculum and teaching problem."
