### State Workers Total 1,444 In Oakland

Almost five per cent of the 31,500 state classified employees are stationed in Oakland County according to a Michigan Civil Service Commission study. The study shows 1,444 state workers in Oakland County with the largest number assigned throughout Michigan's 82 other counties.

Although 7,065 state employees are assigned to Ingham County, where the State Capitol is located in Lansing, Lapeer County in Michigan's Upper Peninsula has by far the largest percentage of state employees per total population.

THE U.S. CENSUS shows Lapeer County has 7,784 people with 682 state workers stationed there, or over eight per cent of its population. Ingham County is second with a total population of 211,834 and 7,065 state workers, or about 3.3 per cent.

Other counties with over 1,000 state employees include: Wayne (4,560), Kalamazoo (1,817), Washtenaw (1,393), Jackson (1,187) and Lapeer (1,077).

The study shows the fewest state employees, only four, are stationed in Missaukee County.

"THE FIGURES illustrate the widely diverse services performed by state employees for people in every area of Michigan," said Franklin K. DeWald, state personnel director.

"In the smaller counties state hospitals and prisons usually account for the total where there are a relatively large number of employees," he said.

Other agencies which usually account for additional personnel outside the Capitol are the Department of Conservation, State Highway, State Police, Michigan Employment Security Commission, Labor Control Commission and the Department of Social Welfare.

STATE EMPLOYEES classified under civil service constitute the fifth largest work force in Michigan behind General Motors, Ford, Chrysler, and the Federal government.

There are approximately 47,000 federal civil service workers in Michigan.
